1	1.The total number of sections shall be restricted to 13 and further increase shall require
	prior permission of the Board, subject to compliance with the affiliation bye laws and

	availability of class rooms of>500 ft dimension.
2	2. The school has overlaid the ramp on part of a stair case to access the upper floors which is steep and unsafe for CWSN. The school shall dismantle this unsafe ramp and construct a separate ramp as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board. It shall also affix hand rail along the ramp at the entrance of the school and submit compliance of both these points within 3 months on SARAS portal.
3	3. The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets which are too small and narrow for a wheel chair/walker to navigate. The school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage indicating the floor number, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS. The toilets in the first floor have common entry for both Boys and girls. The school is required to provide separate entry for boys and girls and complete the construction work before the beginning of session and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
4	4. The library is still seen as under stocked. No separate reading area for staff is seen. The school shall upgrade its library as per SoP issued by the board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS portal.
5	5. Failure to submit compliance on the above points within prescribed time shall invite financial penalty against the school.
6	6. The school is required to renew all the mandatory certificates from time to time and directed not to remove videography link in future.
7	7. The school shall follow the SoPs of the Board for its labs, library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide Circular no. 11 dated 04.10.2022.
8	8. The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Bhopal.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.
